UGA Summer Music Institute June 5-9

UGA's **Summer Music Institute** boasts a performance-intensive curriculum serving advanced students who are seriously considering music as a major area of study in college. In addition to large ensemble rehearsals and performance, all participants will perform in a chamber ensemble, and choose one elective course for the week. Courses offered in the past have included music history, arranging, music theory, composition, music technology, and conducting. Concentrations include **band, chorus, orchestra, and piano.**

An audition is required. Rising high school sophomores, juniors, and seniors will be considered for the experience following an audition submission and recommendation letter by April 15th.

Sectionals, Masterclasses, Chamber Ensembles, and Music Theory: In addition to orchestra rehearsals, campers will attend sectionals, take music theory, play in small chamber ensembles, and participate in masterclasses.

Orchestral string students age 12 – 18

Middle school students:

Must have at least two years of study and ensemble experience on your concert band or orchestral string instrument prior to camp. Ensemble director's recommendation will be requested. Suzuki Strings: Students should have a minimum of two years of instruction playing grade three repertoire in their school programs and youth orchestras or the equivalent of Suzuki Book 4 for violinist and Suzuki Book 3 for violists, cellists and basses. (Must be age 12 on or before June 1.)

Talented musicians from across the country join together on the beautiful Furman campus to build not only musicianship skills but life-long friendships. For ages 12-18, the students perform in one of four large ensembles (a full symphony orchestra, a string orchestra, and two concert bands) and may audition for a jazz ensemble, various chamber groups, or perform as a soloist on the Honors Solo Recital. In addition to the ensemble rehearsals, sectionals, and master classes, the camp offers courses in basic musicianship, conducting, yoga for musicians and history.
