## **Lettering in Orchestra**

Why letter in orchestra? Whatever grade you're in, before you know it you'll be filling out college applications. When you do, since you can't deliver those apps in person, you're going to want to make sure you look your best on paper, including showcasing all your great high school extracurriculars. Why? Because colleges and universities want students who will contribute positively to their campus community. And, an orchestra letter reflects just that- effort in orchestra above and beyond the classroom and superior dedication to orchestra and your community. Read on for the details...

Students may earn a letter and service bars (in subsequent years) in orchestra through participation in yearlong orchestra and related activities. Below is a list of activities students may complete to earn points and a worksheet to help you keep track of them. We suggest logging points throughout the school year so you are not scrambling to remember your activities at the last minute. NOTE: *You must be enrolled in two semesters of orchestra to qualify for a letter*.

## **Activity Points**

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20 pts.	Participation in 2 semesters of orchestra and all performances
20 pts.	Attending summer school in order to remain in orchestra
15 pts.	Participation in honor orch. (GCYS, ASYO, GSO, EYSO, MYSO) or church orch. for full year
15 pt.	Private lessons on your stringed instrument (per year)
10 pts.	Participation in any other PRHS music class
10 pts.	Summer Music Camp
5 pts.	Participation in Solo and Ensemble Festival
	Add 5 pts. Earning a "i" rating
5 pts.	Entering PTSA Reflections Contest
	Add 5 pts. A. Advancing to county level
	Add 5 pts. B. Advancing to state level
	Add 5 pts. C. Advancing to national level
3 pts.	Performing in ensembles or solos outside of the school orchestra
***	Governor's Honor Program (only one category may count)
	5 pts. a. Participation in district level audition
	10 pts. b. Participation in district and state level auditions
	20 pts. c. Selected for and participation in GHP
***	All-State Orchestra (only one category may count)
	4 pts. a. Participation in district auditions
	7 pts. b. Participation in state-level auditions
	10 pts. c. Selected for and participation in All-State Orchestra
3 pts.	Attendance at a classical music concert
2 pts.	Peer tutoring (per student)
2 pts.	Volunteering at orchestra events at PRHS, Hull, Northbrook (per hour)
***	Miscellaneous- points awarded at directors' discretion

A student may be disqualified from receiving a letter for the following reasons: One unexcused absence from a performance (absence also affects grade); two or more disciplinary referrals during one year in orchestra class; any suspension (in or out of school) that results from misconduct while in orchestra class or on an orchestra related trip or performance; failure to maintain a least a B average in orchestra class for the year.
